Design 4 – Lookbook 18



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 300 (350, 350, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Summer Softness** (80% organic cotton, 20% superfine Merino wool; 130 m/50 g) in Yellow (**col 11**). Size 4 and 6 mm needles; three 28 mm buttons in beige [by Union Knopf, item 454230].

Rib patt: P1, k1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Slip st rib: Set-up row (RS): [K1, p1] 5 times, k1. Row 2 (WS): [Sl 1 pwise wyif, k1] 5 times, sl 1 pwise wyif. Row 3 (RS): [K1, sl 1 pwise wyif] 5 times, k1. Work set-up row once, then rep rows 2 and 3.

Full-fashion decrease [raglan shaping]: At beg of RS row, k1, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Full-fashion decrease [neck shaping]: At beg of RS row, 11 sts in slip st rib, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 13 sts, k2tog, 11 sts in slip st rib.

Gauge: 17 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 6 mm needles.

Back: With size 4 mm needles cast on 93 (99, 105, 111) sts. Next row (RS): * P1, k1; rep from *, end p1. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 4 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Work in St st



for 19 (20, 21, 22) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 30 (33, 36, 39) RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 33 sts.

Left front: With size 4 mm needles cast on 56 (59, 62, 65) sts. Next row (RS): * P1, k1; rep from * to last 12 (11, 12, 11) sts, p1 (p0, p1, p0), work slip st rib over last 11 sts. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 4 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next row (RS): Work 45 (48, 51, 54) sts in St st, work slip st rib as established over last 11 sts. Work in patt as set by last row for 19 (20, 21, 22) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan and neck edge: Work full-fashion decs for raglan shaping at right edge same as for back and **at same time**, work full-fashion decs for neck shaping every alt RS row 15 times = 11 sts rem for neckband. Cont in patt over neckband sts for 17 cm. Bind off all sts.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement and working 3 buttonholes at beg of RS rows as foll: Work slip st rib as established over first 5 sts, bind off 1 st, work to end. Next row (WS): Work to bound-off st, yo, work to end. Next row (RS): Work in slip st rib over first 11 sts (work a sl 1 pwise wyif into yo), work to end. Work first buttonhole when piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, rem 2 buttonholes spaced 8 (8.5, 9, 9.5) cm apart.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 69 (75, 81, 87) sts. Next row (RS): * P1, k1; rep from *, end p1. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 4 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Work in St st for 6 cm, increasing 4 sts evenly across first row = 73 (79, 85, 91) sts. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 30 (33, 36, 39) RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 13 sts.


Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan seams. Sew bound-off edges of neckbands tog, then sew neckband to back neck. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
