

1803 - Striped sweater in double Mayflower Easy Care Classic.

To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crochet.

The entire sweater is knitted in double yarn. In the light purple stripes, the silver thread is also added in the first and last rnd/row. The rnds/rows in between is knitted only in double purple.

Back and front.

Cast on 116(120)124(130)134(140) sts on circular needles US $10\frac{1}{2}$ /UK 2 with double cerise and knit ribbing (alternately knit 1, purl 1). When the ribbing edge measures 5 cm = 10 rnds, continue in stockinette on circular needles US 11/UK 0 and in stripes like so: 16 rnds with light purple (with silver thread in the 1^{st} and the 16^{th} rnd – see description above), 16 rnds with orange, 30(32)34(36)36(38) rnds with cerise = in total 44(45)46(47)48(49) cm. Split the work for armholes at the beginning of the rnd and after 58(60)62(65)67(70) sts.

Back.

Continue back and forth in stockinette with orange. When you have knitted 30(32)34(36)36(38) r, put the middle 14(16)16(17)19(20) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. When the armhole measures 21(22)23(24)25(26) cm, put the remaining 19(19)20(21)21(22) sts on a stitch holder for the shoulder. Knit the other side opposite.

Front.

Knit like the back, but with a deeper neckline: When you have knitted 24 r with orange, put the middle 8(10)10(11)13(14) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. When the sleeve measures 21(22)23(24)25(26) cm, knit the 19(19)20(21)21(22) shoulder sts together with the corresponding shoulder on the back: Put the needles together knit wise and knit the sts together in knit stitches, with 1 sts from each needle. Fasten off at the same time. Knit the other side opposite.

Sleeves.

Cast on 30(30)32(32)34(34) sts with cherise on double pointed needles or circular needles US 101/2/UK 2 and knit around in ribbing like the bottom of the back and front pieces. When the edge measures 5 cm = 10 rnds, continue in stockinette on needles/circular needles US 11/UK Put a marker at the beginning of the rnd. Increase (see the underlined section below) and knit stripes at the same time like so: 8 rnds with light purple (with silver thread on the 1st and 8th rnd), 8(8)10(10)12(12) rnds orange, 16 rnds with light purple (with silver thread on the 1st and 16th rnd), 8 rnds cerise, 8 rnds light purple (with silver thread on the 1st and 8th rnd), 8 rnds orange, 8 rnds light purple (with silver thread on the 1st and 8th rnd) and 8 rnds cerise = in total

82(82)84(84)86(86) rnds = 50(50)52(52)53(53) cm. At the same time increase on the first rnd after the ribbing edge like so: Knit 1 sts, knit 1 through the back loop in the chain between the sts, knit until the last sts, knit 1 through the back loop in the chain between the sts and knit the last sts. Repeat these increases on every 6th rnd a total of 12 times = 54(54)56(56)60(60) sts. When the stripes are done, fasten off all sts loosely. Knit the other sleeve matching.

Neckband.

With cerise and circular needles US 10½/UK 2 knit from the left 13 sts up + the waiting 8(10)10(11)13(14) sts + 13 sts up along the neckline on the fron and 6 sts up + the waiting 14(16)16(17)19(20) sts + 6 sts up along the neckline on the back = in total 60(64)64(66) 70(72) sts. Knit around in ribbing (alternately knit 1 and purl 1). When the edge measures 5 cm, fasten off the sts as they show (knit sts knit wise and purl sts purl wise). Make sure not to make it too tight.

Sew the sleeves on.
