## 1814 - Clinging ladies vest with turtleneck in Mayflower New Sky Light.

<b>Size:</b>	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)
<b>Chest measurement in cm:</b>	88	(92)	96	(100)	104	(108)
<b>Length in cm:</b>	65	(67)	69	(71)	73	(75)
<b>Mocha, Color 164, balls:</b>	5	(5)	6	(6)	7	(7)
<b>Circular needles:</b>	US 4/UK 10 (3½ mm) and US 6/UK 8					
<b>Crochet hook:</b>	US 10/UK 4 (3½ mm)					
<b>Quality:</b>	Mayflower New Sky Light. 35 % Alpaca, 35 % Wool, 30 % Nylon, 300 m pr. 50 gram.					
<b>Gauge:</b>	22 sts and 35 r in stockinette on needles US 6/UK 8 = 10 x 10 cm					

To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crochet.

**Back and front piece:** Cast on 208(216)226(234)244(252) sts on circular needles US 4/UK 10 and knit 5 cm ribbing (alternately knit 1 and purl 1). Then change to circular needles US 6/UK 8 and continue in stockinette. Put a marker at the beginning of the round. When the work measures 45(46)47(48)49(50) cm, split it for armholes by the beginning of the round and after 104(108)113(117)122(126) sts.

### Back.

Continue back and forth in stockinette, while fastening off for armhole in both sides on every other row 2 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts = 76(80)85(89)94(98) sts. Then continue working straight until the armhole measures 24(25)26(27)28(29) cm. Put the middle 32(34) 37(39)42(44) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. When the armhole measures 26(27)28(29)30(31) cm, put the remaining 19(20)21(22)23(24) sts on a stitch holder for the shoulder. Knit the other side opposite.

### Front.

Knit like the back, but with a deeper neckline: When the armhole measures 21(22)23 (24)25(26) cm, put the middle 8(10)13(15) 18(20) sts on a stitch holder for the neckline and finish each side apart. Fasten off in the neck side on every other row another 1 x 5 sts, 1 x 4 sts, 1 x 3 sts, 1 x 2 sts and 1 x 1 sts. When the armhole measures 26(27)28(29)30(31) cm, knit the remaining 19(20)21(22)23(24) shoulder stitches together with the corresponding shoulder on the back: put the needles together knit wise, and knit the sts together in knit sts with 1 sts from each needle. Fasten off at the same time. Knit the other side opposite.

### Collar.

With circular needles US 4/UK 10 knit from the left shoulder 25 sts up + the waiting 8(10)13(15)18(20) sts + 25 Sts up along the neckline on the front piece and 6 sts up + the waiting 32(34)37(39)42(44) sts + 6 sts up along the neckline on the back piece = in total 102(106)112 (116)122(126) sts. Knit around in stockinette. When you have knitted 6 cm, change to circular needles US 6/UK 8, while turning the work inside out, so that the rest is knitted in stockinette from the inside. When the collar measures 18 cm – or the desired length – fasten off loosely in knit sts.

### Edges.

With crochet hook US 10/UK 4 crochet 1 round of crab sts (= single crochet made from left to right) along the armhole edges and optionally along the edge of the collar.
