1819 - Sweater with balloon-sleeves in Mayflower New Sky.

Size:	XXS	(XS)	S	(M)	L	(XL)	XXL	(XXXL)	XXXXL
Chest measurement in cm:	85	(95)	105	(115)	125	(135)	145	(155)	165
Length in cm:	54	(56)	58	(60)	62	(62)	64	(66)	68
Color 63, balls:	6	(6)	7	(7)	8	(8)	9	(10)	10
Needles:	US 10/UK 4								
Circular needles (40 cm):	US 10/UK 4								
Quality:	Mayflower New Sky. 35 % Alpaca, 35 % Wool, 30 % Nylon, 150 m pr. 50 gram.								
Gauge:	15 sts x 24 r = 10 x 10 cm.								

To achieve the best result, we recommend using Knit Pro needles, which is the professional tool for knitting and crochet.

It is a good idea to read through the pattern before you start, just like it is a good idea to make a practice swatch and wet block it.

The sweater is knitted in stockinette with double ribbing edges at the bottom, by the sleeves and in the neck.

Procedure.

Back/Front.

1: Cast on 112

(128)144(160)176(192)208(224)240 sts on circular needles US 10/UK 4 and knit 9 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.

2: Knit 30(31) 32(33)34(35)36(37)38 cm stockinette from the ribbing edge. Fasten off for armholes 6 sts in each side and let the work rest. Applies to all sizes.

Sleeves.

1: Cast on 22(24)26(28)30(32)34(36)38 sts on double pointed needles US 10/UK 4 and knit 9 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.

2: Continue in stockinette, knitting every sts twice, knit 1 rnd without increases and 1 rnd increasing to 52(58)64(70) 76(82)88(94)100 sts evenly spread.

3: Continue in stockinette until the stockinette part measures 45(46)47(48)49(50)51(52)53 cm from the ribbing edge or the desired length.

4: Fasten off 6 sts for arm hole and let the work rest. Applies to all sizes.

5: Knit another sleeve matching.

Seaming to raglan.

1: Start with the front piece, one sleeve, the back and the other sleeve.

2: On every other rnd decrease for raglan like so: knit until you have 3 sts left on the front piece, knit 2 together through the back loop, purl 2 (1 sts from the front and 1 from the sleeve), knit 2 sts together. Do the same by the end on the sleeve and the beginning of the back and so on the entire rnd. Applies to all sizes.

3: When you have knitted 14(16)18(20)22(22)24(24)26 raglan decreases, knit back and forth. Make raglan decreases on the right-side row.

4: On the front piece fasten off the middle 12(14)16(18)20(22)24(26(28) sts. Then fasten off 1x3,2x2,3x1 sts towards the neck side. Applies to all sts (the fastened off sts will be over the raglan decreases on the front piece).

5: Knit 2 rows without decreases and fasten off.

Assembly.

1: Knit 84(90)90(96)96(102)102(108)108 sts up all around the neck and knit 9 cm ribbing, knit 1, purl 1. Applies to all sizes.

2: Sew together under the arms.

3: Fold and sew all ribbing edges to the wrong side, so that half of the ribbing edge is on the wrong side and the other half is on the right side. Applies to all sizes.

4: Weave in the ends.

5: Wet block the sweater.
