

# Marigold Shawl

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<b>Size:</b>	
<b>Across, from point to point:</b>	2 x 74 cm = 148 cm
<b>Hight:</b>	Approx. 75 cm
<b>Yarn requirements:</b>	1 ball of 200 g = 600 m
<b>Needles:</b>	Circular needles size 4,0 mm / UK 8 / US 6
<b>Quality:</b>	Mayflower Taormina

The shawl is worked from the middle and outwards.

## Description

The edge stitch (ES) is worked (K) knit on all rows.

**Stockinette stitch:** Knit (K) on the right side, purl (P) on the wrong side.

**Reversed stockinette stitch:** Purl (P) on the right side, knit (K) on the wrong side.

**Pattern:** 2 rows of stockinette stich and 2 rows of reversed stockinette stitch.

**Left side increase (Inc-L):** Work K1 in the left side of the stitch below the last stitch worked - Meaning in the left "leg of the V".

**Right side increase (Inc-R):** Work K1 in the right side of the stitch below the next stitch - Meaning in the right "leg of the V".

## Shawl – begin here:

Cast on 6 stitches and work 1<sup>st</sup> row knit (K).

**Row 2 (right side):** K1 (ES), YO, P1, YO, K2 (center stitches), YO, P1, YO, K1 (ES).

**Row 3 (wrong side):** K1 (ES), TwP1, P1, TwP1, P2 (center stitches), TwP1, P1, TwP1, K1 (ES).

**Row 4 (right side):** ES, K1, Inc-L, K2, Inc-R, place a stitch marker, K2 (center stitches), place a stitch marker, Inc-L, K2, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 5 (wrong side):** ES, P12, ES

**Row 6 (right side):** ES, K1, Inc-L, P4, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-L, P4, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 7 (wrong side):** ES, K6, P2 (center stitches), K6, P1, ES.

**Row 8 (right side):** ES, K1, Inc-L, K6, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-R, K6, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 9 (wrong side):** ES, P9, P2 (center stitches), P9, ES.

**Row 10:** ES, K1, Inc-L, P8, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-L, P8, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 11:** ES, P1, K10, P2 (center stitches), K10, P1, ES.

**\*Row 12:** ES, K1, Inc-L, K10, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-L, K10, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 13:** ES, P13, P2 (center stitches), P13, ES.

**Row 14:** ES, K1, work TwK1 in the chain between the stitches, P12, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-L, P12, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 15:** ES, P1, K14, P2 (center stitches), K14, P1, ES.\*

**Row 16:** ES, K1, Inc-L, K14, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-L, K14, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 17:** ES, P17, P2 (center stitches), P17, ES.

**Row 18:** ES, K1, work TwK1 in the chain between the stitches, P16, Inc-R, K2 (center stitches), Inc-L, P16, Inc-R, K1, ES.

**Row 19:** ES, P1, K18, P2 (center stitches), K18, P1, ES.

Repeat rows 12-15 (from \*-\*) as shown from rows 16-19, where increases are worked on both sides and on both sides of the two center stitches on all right-side rows = 4 increases each time.

Remember all ES are worked (K) knit.

Within the ES-stitches on both sides, the first/last stitch are worked in stockinette stitch, also the two center stitches are worked in

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stockinette stitch. The increases are always worked next to a stockinette stitch.

The stitches between the increases are worked in pattern on the following wrong-side row.

Continue working this way until the yarn runs out – Note: you will need approx. 10 m. of yarn to bind off. Bind off loosely.

Weave in all loose ends.
